




In issuing List No. 10 the same format has been retained, all new items and amendments received up to the 28th February, 1979, have been incorporated.

At present an effort is being made to clear up any anomolies that exist and ensure that the back up files contain all the factual documents. I would, therefore, like to reiterate that the accuracy of the list can only be maintained by the receipt of up to date information, i.e. new items, deletions and sales, etc.

I have included in the list items where advance notification of consideration for listing has been received from the Department of the Environment. Please ensure that until listing has been confirmed, when normal procedures apply, notification of proposed works are sent to me for clearance with the D.O.E.

In the Statistical information on page 2, Listed Buildings Code 1 include functional stations which are in whole or part Listed: closed stations, goods sheds, offices, dwellings and so forth are included against Code 3. In the table showing the number of Conservation Areas Code 7 refers to Areas which include or abut onto railway lines (either operational or closed) but do not include any buildings. A number of Conservation Areas contain more than one feature and these are included against the highest Code that is applicable. Again, Codes 1 and 2 refer to functional stations while closed stations are generally shown against Codes 5 and 6.

The Local Authorities shown in this List are, generally, District Councils, Borough Councils, etc., in whose area the item occurs and in some cases they may not be the same as the Issuing Authority.
